Hello! My name is " [REDACTED] " and I am currently incarcerated at Bridgeport, Ct. Correctional Facility.

Unfortunately it is sad that the reason why I am here, But the reason for my writing you is that I would like to bring upon a lawsuit against the State of Connecticut's Criminal Justice System.

The Judicial System here in our state has been treating people of color, immigrants, and minorities unfair for decades now. They playing favorites by disproportionately incarcerating, policing and sentencing minorities, blacks at higher rates more than our white counterparts.

And also sentenced to incarceration rather than community sentences and to receive longer sentences. Leads me to believe and others in my situation that the crime does not fit the punishment.

While there is not convincing evidence of widespread racial bias in sentencing, there is credible evidence that black defendants are treated differently.

The privileged are rehabilitated, the underprivileged are incarcerated.

And the State Judicial Public Defenders work with the prosecution to incarcerate the disadvantaged to substantial amounts of time with so called Deals, and plea bargains knowing that we the people who so call offend have no choice but to accept these so called deals that are no bargains at all.

Then it (The Program) was called Day-Top Rehab in "Bridgeport" which was under investigation for mistreatment of its clients and was re-named the "Cpt Foundation" and fired its current staff members and hired new staff.

I have begged and pleaded for help, but to no avail. All I receive is time in jail, which makes people like myself who keep getting sentences angry at Society for not caring enough and choosing money over rehabilitation.

Yes, you do know yourself that this is a Billion Dollar a year business and is nothing but the warehousing of Americas Poor. There is billions in the Criminal Justice System, (crime) money in crime. IT'S NOT ABOUT Justice anymore, Punishment and more Punishment.
