XXIVth CONGRESS—SECOND SESSION.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 11.—Wade presented a petition from citizens of Philadelphia urging Congress to "stand firm" for the Union.

Crittenden presented petitions from citizens of Massachusetts, Indiana and Missouri for a settlement of the present difficulties.

Bigler presented fifty petitions in favor of Crittenden's resolutions also one to submit the question to the people.

Craig of N. C. offered a preamble and resolutions acknowledging the formation of the Southern Confederacy and its independence.

A resolution was adopted, calling on the President to furnish the facts relative to the seizure of public property in Louisiana and what steps had been taken or were contemplated to recover possession thereof.

Mr. Lincoln left this morning, accompanied by over one thousand people to the depot, where, after shaking hands, said: "No one, not in my position, can appreciate the sadness I feel at parting. A duty devolving upon me, which, perhaps, is greater than has devolved upon any other since the days of Washington, and the never would have succeeded but for the aid of Divine Providence, upon which he at all times relied. I feel that I cannot succeed without the same Divine aid which sustained him, and the same Almighty Being I place my reliance for my support. I hope you, my friends, will all pray that I may receive that Divine assistance, without which I cannot succeed, but with which success is certain. Again I bid you all an affectionate farewell."

The President felt evinced great emotion, and his old neighbors were affected to tears. Major Hunter, Col. Sumner, Ellsworth, Lamont, and others, accompany Mr. Lincoln. Mrs. Lincoln joins her husband in New York next week.

Stephens, in response to the serenade given him, said that "this day ushered in another new Republic, which will secure more perfectly our peace, prosperity and domestic tranquility. What will be our future depends on ourselves. Although but six States form our present government, our future prospects are as bright as those of the original thirteen. All Republics depend upon the virtue and intelligence of their people, and resting our faith on these, we fear nothing for the future."
