FROM WASHINGTON. WASHINGTON, April 20.—The Council resolved to provide for the families of volunteers. The State Bank offered \$50,000 to the Government.

About fifteen Massachusetts soldiers are in the hospital and doing well. They are in good spirits. The steamer Pawnee left last night with Government troops on board.

BALTIMORE, April 20.—The city is getting excited. Military and armed men are moving in every direction. The Mayor and the Governor have notified the President that no more troops can pass through Baltimore unless they fight their way.

The bridges on the Northern and Central roads are all destroyed. The number of killed yesterday was eleven citizens, three Massachusetts soldiers. Wounded four citizens and eight soldiers.

PHILADELPHIA ITEMS. PHILADELPHIA, April 20.—Letters from Gov. Letcher have been received by the possessor of a bullet, offering \$3,000 for it. He replied: "No money could purchase it to use against my country."

A resident of Kent County has received information that the negroes are burning the houses of the whites. Two of his buildings are already destroyed. The President says no more troops will be brought through Baltimore, provided they are allowed to pass around the city unimpeded.

PROGRESS OF THE SEVENTH REGIMENT. PHILADELPHIA, April 20.—The New York Seventh Regiment arrived at one, and are waiting orders. The members are anxious to go through Baltimore.

The Seventh Regiment and Massachusetts Regiment are at the Railroad depot getting ready to start. It is reported they go to Havre de Grace and from thence by water to Annapolis.

RAILROAD BRIDGES DESTROYED. PHILADELPHIA, April 19.—The Railroad bridge three miles north of Baltimore is reported to be burning. All the bridges between Baltimore and Havre de Grace are destroyed or rendered useless.

The Southern train due here at eleven has arrived. The Seventh Regiment and others are still at the depot.

HARBOR FOR NORFOLK. NEW YORK, April 20.—The steamship Chesapeake sails for Norfolk this afternoon with 250 men for the Navy yard. The steamer Monticello sails this afternoon with 100 men for Norfolk.

NEW YORK, April 20.—The Edinburg has sailed for Europe with 241 passengers—no troops.

A LOYAL VIRGINIAN. NEW YORK, April 20.—The Tribune has a special dispatch stating that the Governor of Virginia sent a messenger to a meeting instructing the collector to seize the Government property there, but he refused and armed himself and others and announced his determination to stand by the Government.

ADDITIONAL TROOPS ORDERED OUT. ALBANY, April 20.—The Governor has ordered two regiments from New York and two from Brooklyn, in addition to those already ordered.
