MILITARY MOVEMENTS.

WASHINGTON, May 29.—The following from a reporter of the Associated Press at Fortress Monroe, dated Monday evening, is just received.

A force of 2,500 men, embracing the Vermont and Fourth Massachusetts Regiments, and the Steuben Rifles of New York, and a few regulars and four pieces of artillery, formed to-day an entrenched camp at Newport, near the mouth of James River, and about ten miles from the fortress across Hampton Roads.

The rebel battery fired four shots at the Empire City and Quaker City when off Sewall's Point. Though over three miles distant, the shots fell little short, indicating guns of heavy calibre.

The Point of Newport like Sewall's Point, is in plain sight from the ramparts of Fort Monroe.

The roadstead there is about three miles wide.

The object of the entrenched camp is to command Sand Island, which is about midway between and completely guards the entrance to James River.

Gen. Butler was fearful that the rebels would take possession of the island.

IMPORTANT FROM NORFOLK. BALTIMORE, May 29.—The steamer Georgiana has arrived from Fortress Monroe, leaving there at six o'clock last evening. A small steamer from Norfolk, under a flag of truce, had just landed over a hundred refugees on the Cumberland, mostly the wives and children of the laborers in the Navy Yard.

They state that there are from 700 to 900 troops at Norfolk and Portsmouth. Beauregard had not arrived at Norfolk. The Louisiana and Georgia troops were the best equipped and disciplined.

Butler in Norfolk was worth 50 cents, Hams 25 cents per pound, and other provisions were high in proportion. Sixty-seven Union votes were cast in Norfolk. Perfect gloom and terror pervades the community.

Several batteries had been erected between Monroe and Norfolk. That on Craney Island commanding the approach at Norfolk and Portsmouth has embrasures for forty guns.

The Federal encampment at Newport Point has thus far been undisturbed. GRAFTON, VA., OCCUPIED BY THE FEDERAL TROOPS.

CINCINNATI, May 29.—On Sunday night, Col. Kelly, in command of the First Regiment of Virginia Volunteers, received marching orders. He left Wheeling at 7 o'clock, on Monday morning, towards Grafton. After their departure, the 10th Ohio Regiment, 1000 strong, under Col. Urbine, crossed the Ohio river and followed Kelly's Regiment. About the same time, the 14th Ohio Regiment, under Col. Steadman, crossed the Ohio at Marietta and occupied Parkerburg.

At midnight, on Monday, the rebels evacuated Grafton in great haste. Col. Kelly is probably in possession of Grafton this morning.

SECESSIONIST IN JAIL AT WASHINGTON. WASHINGTON, May 26.—The eight secession soliers captured in Virginia are in jail. The thirty-five cavalry made prisoners at Alexandria will be jailed to await the action of the military authorities.

A Clerk of a department was examined this morning and testimony which shows that he was in correspondence with Dudley Mann, as an old personal friend, will be placed in the hands of General Mansfield.

ARRIVAL OF PENNSYLVANIA TROOPS IN BALTIMORE. BALTIMORE, May 29.—A Regiment of Pennsylvanians who have been encamped at Perryville some weeks, arrived here this morning, marched to the Northern Central Depot and took the cars. It is understood that their destination is Gettysburg and thence to Harperstown. This indicates Harper's Ferry.

MOVEMENT OF TROOPS. NEW YORK, May 29.—The steamer State of Georgia was passed off Cape May last night with Colonel Allen's regiment aboard for Fort Monroe.

The steamer Coalbrookdale with Bartlett's Naval Brigade for Fort Monroe, sailed at daylight this morning.
