

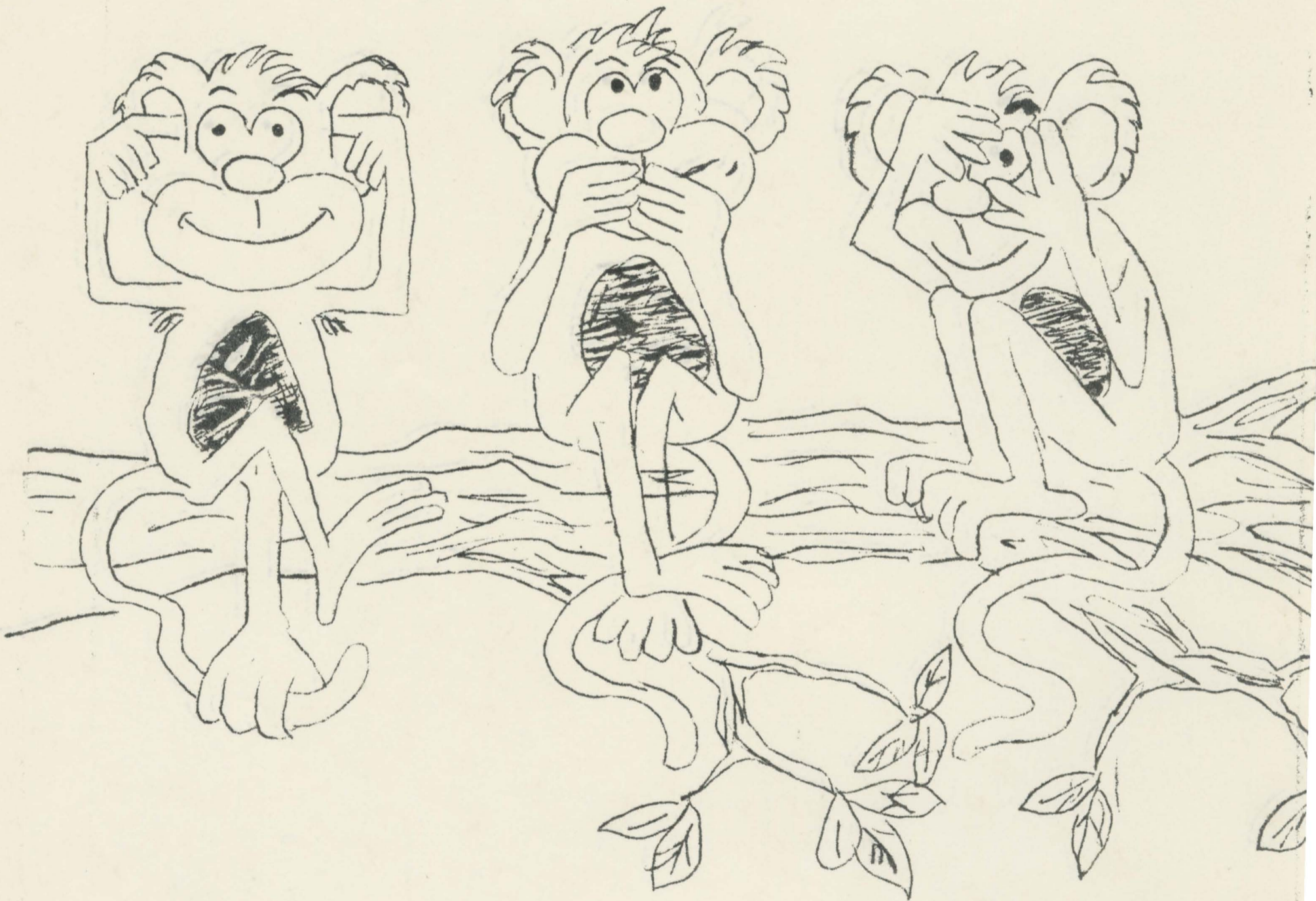

OFFICIAL NOTICES TO ALL INMATES

~~LEGAL ASSISTANCE TO PRISONERS.~~ Free legal assistance to all inmates is provided throughout the Connecticut Correctional Center by an organization called Legal Assistance to Prisoners. (L.A.P.)

Attorney Randi Mezzy from L.A.P. visits our institution once a week to help the inmates with their civil and legal problems.

L.A.P. Cannot help inmates with criminal cases. These must go to the public Defenders Office or to private attorneys. You can contact Atty. Randi Mezzy by writing to her at the L.A.P. office, address: 340 Capitol Ave. Hartford, Connecticut 06115.

~~COOP SERVICES.~~ The Coop Multi-Service Center is an agency that serves ex-offenders in the Greater Bridgeport area. The service provides, through staff or referral and job counseling, employment referrals, educational counselling, clothing and housing. The COOP deals with men and women presently incarcerated or recently released from a correctional center. They bridge the gap between the ex-offenders immediate needs and the communities resources. The goal of COOP is to help ex-offenders to help themselves. For more information, contact Rev. Smith - submit a request to your counselor.

11 PM - COUNT - This concerns ALL East Wing inmates - READ THIS CAREFULLY. Immediately following the 11 pm count, all inmates are expected to stay in their cells and to remain there for the entire evening. The only exception will be going to and from the lavatory or to inform an officer of something. Any inmate found out of his cell loitering, talking loudly, etc., will be subject to immediate disciplinary action. This comes directly from Warden Liburdi.

~~NATHY RICHER~~ - is the drug counselor for the Regional Narcotics Program. She will be available in the New Building on Fridays from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

The Old Building schedule is as follows; Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. Tuesday, from 1 pm to 3:30 pm. One to one counselling and group counselling opportunities will be available to inmates.

RADIOS IN THE EAST WING CAN BE PLAYED AFTER 11:00 PM ONLY IF EARPHONES ARE USED.

~~MAIL FOR THE WARDENS.~~ All mail or messages for Warden Liburdi or Deputy Wardens Gillis and Goldson is to be placed in the mailbox marked "COMMISSIONERS MAIL". These boxes are located where all other boxes for mail and requests are located. This applies to both the Old and New Centers.

~~FOOD IN CELLS.~~ As per order of the Administration, no food is allowed in cells other than that which was purchased in the commissary. This rule will be strictly enforced by all Shift-Supervisors. Violations may result in Disciplinary action. The purpose of this rule is to cut down on possible health hazards. The exterminators are kept busy enough as it is.

~~CONTACT VISITS.~~ Pre-trial visiting is extending a privilege to inmates in the pre-trial unit who meet the criteria specified in the New Inmate Handbook for contact visits. The visiting list for contact visits shall be reviewed by your Classification Committee at the time the inmate is initially cleared for contact visits. Any change will be permitted only through counselor referral to the Classification Committee. The lists will include immediate family and girlfriends only.

~~I.D. PHOTOS.~~ You are required to have your identification cards on your person at all times during movement throughout the institution; whether going to visits or to employment areas, counselors offices, classification committee, dining hall, etc. Wear your I.D. card on your shirt pocket in plain view. Doing this will prevent any reprisals or disciplinary reports. No inmate will be allowed movement within the institution without his I.D. card. If you do not have an I.D. card - immediately inform your block C/O.

WEARING OF I.D. CARDS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

Cualquier cambio puede ser permitido solamente por el consejero despues referido al Comidado de Clasificacion, la lista incluye familie y novia solamente.

PROGRAMA DE DROGAS.....

Kathy Richer es la consejera de drogas para el programa de Regional Narcotics. Ella estara en el carcel Nuevo il niernes de 8:30 am hasta 3:30 pm. En el pante viejo hasta ella estara los lunes, miercales, y viernes desde 8:30 am hosta 3:30 pm lo martes de 1 pm hasta 3:30 pm. Tambien hay grupos que conceyan para su bien y estara la oportuniad para quien lo nesesite.

COMIDAS EN LA CELDA.....

Por orden de la Administracion, no deven de tener comida en su celda. Lo unico que pueden tener es lo que compran en la tiendas, esta regla estara rigurosamente enforsada por todos supervisores que trabajan en la institucion. Violaciones de esta order puede resultar en violacion y disciplina. El proposito de esta es para cortal un poco de entermedades que gentes que fulmigan estan mantenido ocupada suficientemente como es.

CIVIL LEGAL ASSISTANCE FOR EX-OFFENDERS

- A. Ex-Offender (Been in jail or prison or convicted of an offense and placed on probation)
- B. Low income (Qualify for legal aid)
- C. Need a lawyer (For non-criminal problems like divorce, eviction, discrimination, child support, bankruptcy, drivers license renewal, or any other civil legal matter)

If you do qualify under all three categories, you can apply for free legal service through Project Advocate of the Connecticut Prison Association. We have volunteer attorneys who will represent you on a no charge basis. The only payment you must make is for court costs and/or fees, if any.

If you think you need legal help with a civil problem, contact one of the following agencies nearest your home for an appointment.

If Project Advocate isn't for you, maybe you know someone who meets the requirements. Help that person by passing the word.

ADVOCATE RULE CONCERNING DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE ACTIONS

If accused of an infraction resulting in a Disciplinary Report, you have the right to choose a staff advocate. His function is to assist you in presenting your version of the situation to the Disciplinary Board. He is required to assist the board in uncovering the true facts of the incident, and does not function as a "Defense Attorney". He is also a resource for you to consult if you have any questions on the nature of the charge and the appropriate penalties which could result. His responsibility to you and to the Center is to assure that proper disposition is taken in regards to the disciplinary process.

MAKE ME CRY THINKING OF THIER CAUSE.

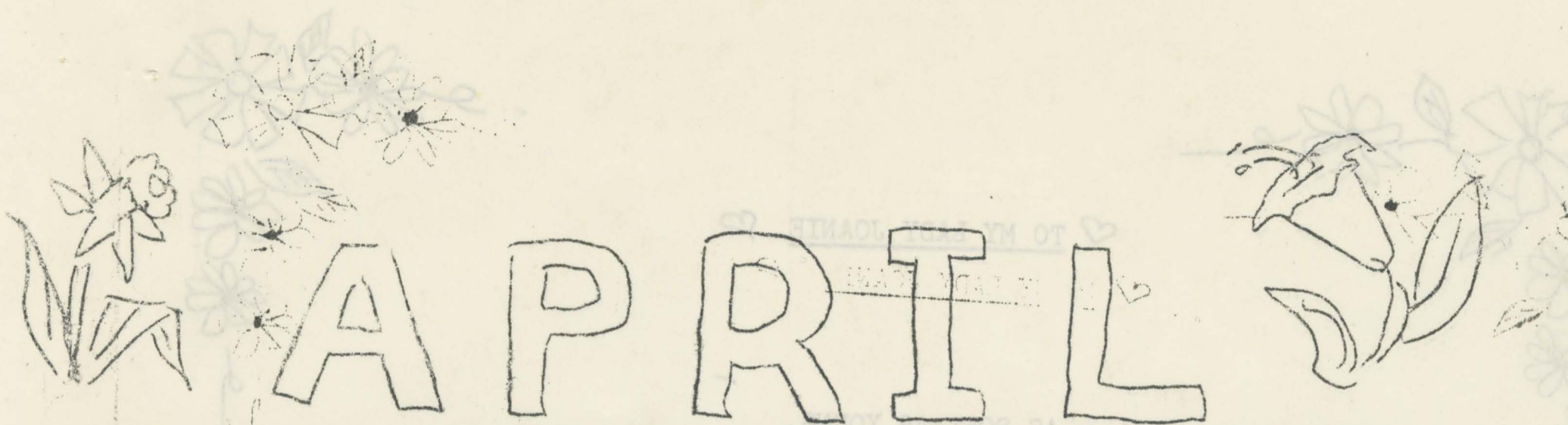
THE ECHOES OF THE DAYS GONE BY

MY ONLY WANT IS FOR YOU AND YOUR LOVE.

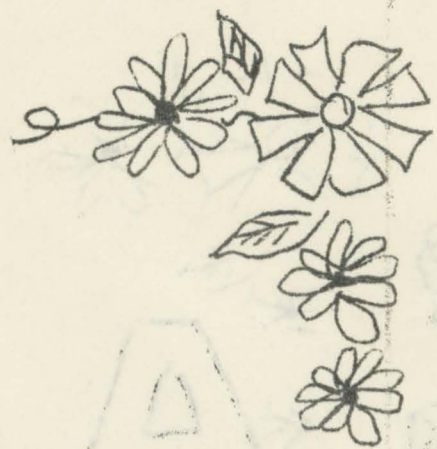
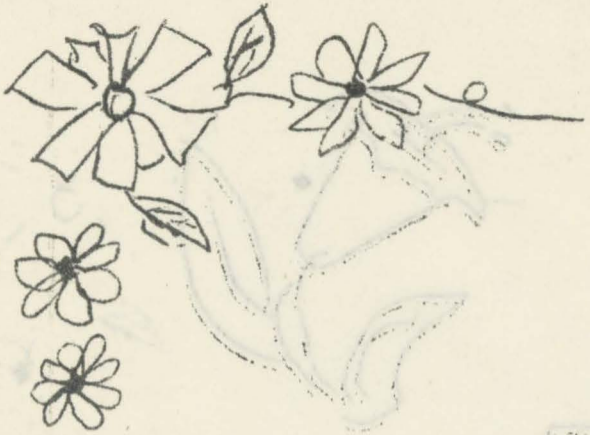

THE TOLL BLACK EXPERIENCE by RORY ANDERSON

This is an open letter to the brothers that find themselves incarcerated. Some people say you got to jail, some people say you got to do your own time. But what you really got to do is get out period. Jail started out as a place to put people who violated the laws of the land. But, due to the indifference in a communistic society, jail has become just another status symbol. You heard people before; "man, I just did a 5 to 10 so you better leave me alone". People dont see jail as a correctional institution anymore, its just a place to do time. You cant be rehabilitated in jail nomore. You cant learn a trade in jail either unless there's a growing demand for tiermen. THE GOVERNMENT DONT CARE EITHER SO DONT ASK HIM FOR HELP. The problem is on us inmates to digest. What to do? Stop giving the C.O.'s jobs. JUST STOP COMING TO JAIL. Imagine if there was no inmates in this jail. Imagine if all the judges and police and public defenders were out of work. What if you seen so-and-so at the unemployment office. Dont think I'm dreaming, cause I'm not. I'm not fantasizing either. Were it not for the repeat offenders their would only be about four or five people in here right now. Seven out of every ten of us is here for the second or third time. When we get thirty or forty and look back, were gonna say 'where were we when we were 20?

We ask- how could he possibly have done so much for us? " The answer is really simple- he loved and he loves us that much, back then and here and now.

One of the saddest events in anyone's life is not to realize the love that Jesus has for us, and one of the greatest mistakes that can actually cripple us is- not to believe in that love and allow ourselves to despair.

For those who are Catholic, who believe in Confession (now called the rite of Reconciliation) and want to partake of the love of Jesus in a special way by going to confession, and feel funny about going to the sacrament because it has been so long since you went to confession, we suggest the following leave a note in your counselor's box for either Father Como or Sister Ann and we will help you to get your act together so you can enjoy the peace and love that this tremendously healing sacrament can bring.
