

**LEGAL ASSISTANCE TO PRISONERS:** Free legal assistance to all inmates is provided through all Connecticut Centers by an organization call Legal Assistance To Prisoners (L.A.P.) Attorney Randy Mezzy from L.A.P. visits our institution once a week to help the inmates with their civil and legal problems! L.A.P. not help inmates with criminal cases

These must go to the Public Defenders Office or to private Atty. You can contact Atty. Randy Mezzy by writing to her at the L.A.P. office address: 340 Capitol Ave. Hartford, Ct. 06115

**CO-OP SERVICES:** The CO-Op Multi-Service Center is an agency that serves ex-offenders in the Greater Bridgeport area. The service provides through staff or referral, job counseling, employment referrals, educational counseling, clothing and housing. CO-OP deals with men and women presently incarcerated or recently released from a Correctional Center. They bridge the gap between ex-offenders immediate needs and the communities resources. The goal of CO-Op is to help ex-offenders to help themselves. For more information contact Rev. Smith by submitting a request to your counselor.

**11 P.M. COUNT:** This concerns all East Wing inmates. Carefully and Immediately following the 11 P.M. count, all inmates are expected to stay in their cells and to remain there for the entire evening. The only exception will be going or coming, to or from the laundry or to inform an officer of something. Any inmate found outside of his cell loitering, talking loud, etc. will be subject to immediate disciplinary action.

**Kathy Richer:** She is the drug counselor for the Regional Narcotics Program. She will be available in the new building on Fridays from, 8:30 A.M. to 3:30 P.M. The old building as follow, Wednesday and Thursday for groups 1:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M.

Monday and Tuesday for counseling, time is flexible. One to one counseling and group counseling is available to all inmates.

**MAIL FOR THE WARDENS:** All mail or messages for Warden William Tuthill, Warden Bruce Goldson, or Deputy Warden Robert Gillis is to be placed in the mailbox marked "WARDEN". This box is located in the old building by the entrance of the Mess Hall new center- in each block by mailboxes.

**CONTACT VISITS:** Pre-trial visiting is extended as a privilege to inmates in the pre-trial unit who meet the criteria specified in the New Inmate Handbook for contact visits. The visiting list for contact visit will be reviewed by your Classification Committee at the time the inmate is initially cleared for contact visits. Any change will be permitted only through counselor referral to the Classification Committee. The list will include immediate family and girlfriend only...

**I.D. PHOTOS:** You are required to have your identification cards on your person at all times during movement throughout the institution, whether going to visits or employment areas, counselors office, classification committee, dining hall, etc. Wear your I.D. card in your shirt pocket in plain view. Doing this will prevent any reprisals or disciplinary reports. NO inmate will be allowed movement within the institution without his I.D. card. If you do not have an I.D. card immediately inform your block C/O. WEARING OF I.D. CARDS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

## ADVOCATE RULE CONCERNING DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE ACTIONS

If accused of an infraction resulting in a Disciplinary Report, you have the right to choose a staff advocate. His function is to assist you in presenting your version of the situation to the Disciplinary Board. He is required to assist the board in uncovering the true facts of the incident, and does not function as a "Defense Attorney". He is also a resource for you to consult if you have any questions on the nature of the charge and the appropriate penalties which could result. His responsibility to you and to the Center is to assure that proper disposition is taken in regards to the disciplinary process.

THE COLLECTION OF PAPERBACKS AVAILABLE FROM THE LIBRARY HAS BEEN DONATED TO THE CENTER BY REV. FRANK DENTON AND REV. FATHER COMO. ALSO, CREDIT SHOULD BE GIVEN TO DARIEN BOOKAID, AN ORGANIZATION WHICH MAKES READING MATERIALS AVAILABLE TO STATE INSTITUTIONS WITHOUT COST TO INMATES. WE HERE AT THE INSTITUTION ARE GRATEFUL FOR THEIR UNENDING DONATIONS AND CONCERN.

IF YOU WISH TO BORROW BOOKS, LOOK FOR THE LIBRARY CART WHICH CIRCULATES THROUGHOUT THE INSTITUTION EACH WEEKDAY MORNING AND AFTERNOON. YOU MAY BORROW AS MANY PAPERBACKS AS YOU WISH, WITHIN REASON. WE ASK YOUR COOPERATION IN RETURNING THESE BOOKS WHEN YOU HAVE FINISHED READING THEM--OR GIVE THEM TO OTHER INMATES SO THAT AS MANY BOOKS AS POSSIBLE WILL BE AVAILABLE AND IN CIRCULATION.

LAW LIBRARY

IF YOU WISH TO USE THE LAW LIBRARY-FILL OUT A COUNSELOR REQUEST SLIP ASKING YOUR COUNSELOR FOR PERMISSION TO USE THE LAW LIBRARY.

WHEN UTILIZING THE LAW LIBRARY, PLEASE BEAR IN MIND THAT THESE ARE YOUR LAW BOOKS AND MATERIALS, AND IT IS UP TO ALL CONCERNED TO CARE FOR THE MATERIALS THERE. IN THE PAST THESE MATERIALS HAVE BEEN TORN, MUTILATED AND STOLEN.

WHEN YOU USE BOOKS OR OTHER MATERIALS FROM THE LAW LIBRARY-PLEASE RETURN THEM AS YOU FOUND THEM-ANOTHER INMATE MAY NEED THEM TO ASSIST WITH HIS LEGAL WORK ON HIS CASE. IT CANNOT BE STRESSED ENOUGH HOW IMPORTANT THESE MATERIALS ARE TO THOSE WHO SEEK LEGAL ASSISTANCE.

SENTENCED MEN WILL BE CALLED OVER THE PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM TO COME TO THE LAW LIBRARY WHICH IS LOCATED IN THE SCHOOL BUILDING--OR A PASS WILL BE ISSUED TO THE PERSON REQUESTING USE OF THE LAW LIBRARY. THIS PROCEDURE WILL APPLY TO ALL THOSE WHO RESIDE IN THE EAST WING. PRE-TRIAL MEN WILL BE CALLED TO THE COUNSELING AREA WHERE THE LAW LIBRARY IS LOCATED.

AS FAR AS IS POSSIBLE, YOU WILL BE ALLOWED WHATEVER TIME YOU NEED WITHIN THE ESTABLISHED INSTITUTIONAL SCHEDULE.

MATERIALS IN THE LAW LIBRARY MAY NOT BE BORROWED UNLESS SPECIAL PERMISSION HAS BEEN GRANTED. ANYONE FOUND WITH, OR HAVING MATERIALS THAT WERE REMOVED FROM THE LAW LIBRARY WITHOUT SPECIAL PERMISSION, IS AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO A DISCIPLINARY REPORT.

IF YOU WISH TO BORROW REFERENCE MATERIALS OTHER THAN LAW LIBRARY MATERIALS, YOU SHOULD MAKE OUT YOUR REQUEST TO THE LIBRARIAN WHO WILL SIGN THE MATERIALS OUT FOR YOU. THE MATERIALS MUST BE RETURNED WITHIN ONE WEEK TO MAKE THEM AVAILABLE TO OTHERS. PERIODICALLY, A LIST OF REFERENCE MATERIALS MAINTAINED IN THE LIBRARY WILL BE PUBLISHED IN THE SCROLL.

this week in PILALIAN BLACK HISTORY

AUGUST 25, 1746- lucy terry, a slave in deerfield mass, has  
commemorate an indian raid on the colony in her poem,  
BARS fight. she was one of the earliest BLACK POETS writing  
the colony, and authorities say her poem gives a better version  
on the raid by indian warriors then any of her contemporary  
writers.

AUGUST 29, 1920 CHARLES (YARDBIRD) PARKER, one of the founders  
of the modern JAZZ MOVEMENT and famous alto SAXOPHONIST ,  
was born in kansas city, mo. parker left school at age 15.  
To become a professional MUSICIAN, and spent his early years  
with a group of FUN-LOVING music makers in kansas city.  
after wandering about the midwest for a time parker arrived  
in new york in 1939 in the early 1940s parker play with  
THE bands of earl hines, and kirk, noble sissie, as well  
as the original BILLY ECKSTINE band.what charlie parker  
CONTRIBUTED in the melodic domain is much clearer in his

improvisation then in his original themes, "BIRD" set  
himself apart from his predecessor by an admirable  
boldness in his invention and by revolutionary tonal  
conceptions, in the years before his death in 1955, bird  
confined most of his activity to working with a quintet  
in the new york area, making its final appearance at  
BIRD-LAND. the club which been named in his honor






