But for the man who can't... adjustment is hell... he suffers because he either attacks himself, his fellow inmates or worst still guards.. counselors and sometimes oven a warden. Usually the man who makes policy is protected In his office on the outside. Officc doors... prison bars. protect him from any hostility that may exist.. yeah... adjustment is

Humiliation... they strip-search you unpon admission... look up your as_h_...Humilation, yeah...jail is hell. Given a number...
hell-hole for a cell... Thrown into the "lion's den" with all sorts of criminals... rapist.... killer's.... robberts... no matter that you were arrested for cashing, a bad check. Half of the population belongs in an institution for the criminally, insene. But for a better place to put them they throw them in jail. Humiliation... yeah, jail is hell. \& scar is left permenantlyo.. there is no human being on Goc's earth that can live through this hell and not be nsgatively affected. The scar will bo there for the world to see for the rest of his life.

Acjustment came herr for me.. I was first incercerated in Chesire IEformetory for $2-5$ years. Fifteen months... first five months was holl. Ten misconduct reports in three months. Three visits to solitary confine ment, "the hole" as we. know it. Eight.osixtcen and thirty days. Defore I realize it I had lost 10 months good-time. Time that I hadn't even earn. Yeah... adjustment was hell. Sull__reports... fiehting unnecessary, wastoing food, talking cell to cell.... petty stuff that could heve been avoidoc. Fut at last... somethine happen to me that don't often happen until it's to latce One night while I was sitting in my cell, the thought came to me; "what is your main objection right now?" The answer of courso was gettin out as soon as possible. The noxt question I asked mysolf was, "what do you do to accomplish this? This question hed to be thou ht out carefully. It took me awhile. . but while I wes tryins to figure out what to do I started to grow. I started to become a man and be responsible for my actions. All this aggrossion I was putting out negatively had to be channeled in a positive direction. As I crow I learn to do this. I started to exert mysclf at. the job I was assignod to (marker shop). I starter? thinking before I made any moves. I went the last 12 months without a misconduct roport. Guards started to over-look little things that in the past they would heve busted me for. I was adjusting... kecpine my nose clean. One thing yrou have to watchout for. (continued on next page)

Becoming institutionalize... Not being able to eacjust to life on the outside. We can deal with that at anothor time. Richt now I'm dealing with adjustine to prison life.

Later I would 80 to prison.. three times... but that is my problem. I was able to arijust to the prison... but staying away from drugs was another thing. WE can also deal with this later. Whatevor your problem.. whatever is on your mind.. we can doal with it
Cbse fll: Greg to came to me the othcr day with a serious problem. The brother was due for release on wecnesclay. Ie-entry furlouh pepers were filled out. his people was notified and because of poor commuication between staff membors Greg the was not allowed to go home on time. Sure waiting one day may not seem like to much to ask, but when you are prepare montally for leavine... 24 hours can be an etcrnity. Not only was this poor communication- this was a mattor whore the staff showo that thoy just don't care alout an inmate, They refuse to soe you as a humen boine in trouble; a person in dire need of some help. Decause of the staff's attitude Gree $\mathrm{A}_{\mathrm{o}}$ didn't o home on time, My advice to Groe was that he should talk to someone immediately. See someone a step hichor then the cunselor that he was doaling with. Create some concern for yourself. They dn't care $n$ ut ,ull so you have to creade your own interest. Make someone do something by nentel action not physical... that can only lead to trouble for yourself and you will never get out of here.

## AYATOLLAH'S ADDICTS

"It is a sin to drink wine or any other drink that incluces drunkonoss," the Koran says. "It is not a sin to use opium or hashish, even in liquid form' Therefore, the 300,000 drus addicts of Teheran measure out the days of their desperate lives comforted by a partial religious absolution.

The Ayatollah's addicts and the drug deal ${ }^{\prime}$ g are confined to a small overcrowded city-within-a-city in a section of the Iranian capital called the South Bazear. There, among the disenfranchised, the outcasts, the desitute, the clesire for death is often stronger than the will to live. Their condition is an inheritance from the departed Shah. Lut the benefits of the Islanic revolution have not yet touched them. Gind though the Koran parclons the addicts and gives hope to the oppressed, most of those who exist in South Dazaar have little hope left.

Hundreds of clealers - it was alleged that thoy wore supplied by higher ups in the Shah's adminstration - from all over the Middle East furnish the addicts with their deadly needs. In the rad licht districts, young girls are offered for a few clollars for whatever sexual ploasure a man micht clesire. This in the face of the Khomeini regime's attempt to wipe out vice in the name of Islam, wherever it is found. Malefactors are immediately tried and harshly punished; sometimes the sentence is death, with no appeal. Lut the addicts and their parisitic suppliers are exempt from punishment; the Koran tells them so - or is it the recognition by the recime that the uncontrollable cannot be controlled?

The late French author Albert Camus wrote "The sign of youth is a wonclerful facility for being happy." Dut to the young here, youth never existed.
