

#### PERSONAL TYPEWRITING

The personal typing course is designed to instruct and guide the students toward a degree of competency in typing according to the interest and effort he displays and exerts.

"Touch typing" was the name used a few years ago to describe the method of teaching-learning employed, but in reality it boils down to the hackneyed expression, 'practice makes perfect'.






SOLDIER IN THE RAIN with Steve McQueen, Jackie Glesson, Tuesday Weld Directed by Ralph Nelson
