PERSONAL TYPEWRITING

The personal typing course is designed to instruct and guide the students toward a degree of competency in typing according to the interest and effort he displays and exerts.

"Touch typing" was the name used a few years ago to describe the method of teaching-learning employed, but in reality it boils down to the hackneyed expression, 'practice makes perfect'.

The men meet with the instructor twice a week, Tuesday and Thursday from 5:45 to 7:45. They may also practice in the typing room on Monday, Wed. and Thursday evenings during recreation time as they seem appropriate.

The class follows no strict schedule and each student can progress at his own rate. He is free to repeat a lesson or go on as his desires dictate. This individual instruction is necessitated by the fact that turnover occurs according to each student's need in terms of time available.

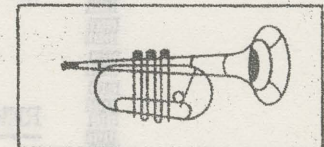
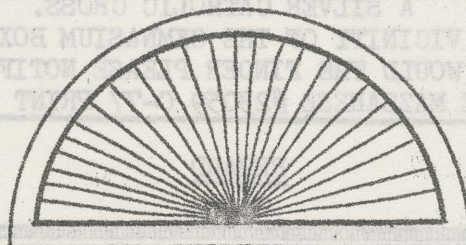

SOLDIER IN THE RAIN

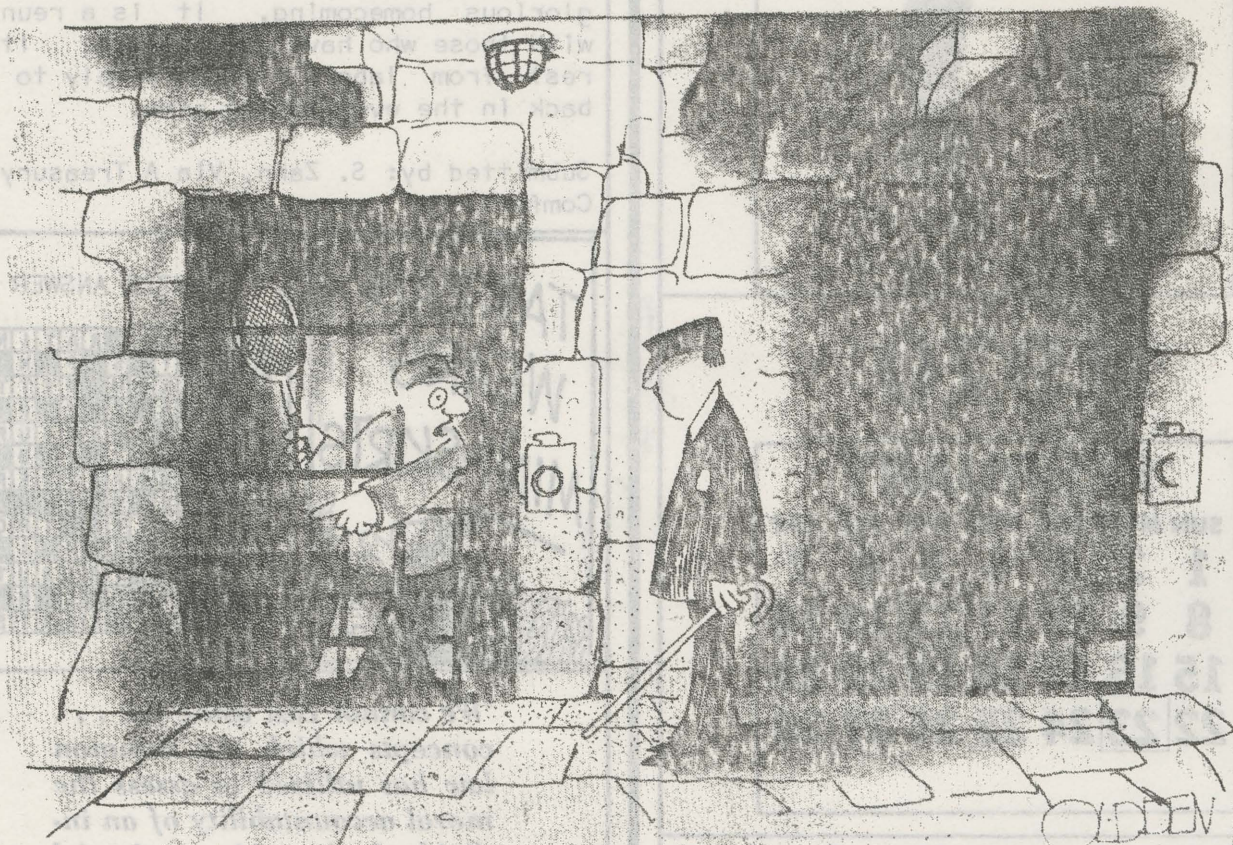
with Steve McQueen, Jackie Gleason, Tuesday Weld

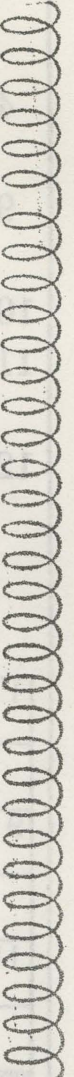
