

LAW PAGE CONT. FROM PART (1)
SIXTH AMENDMENT RIGHT TO COUNSEL.

The cases cited by the Court hold that binding decisions of trial strategy cannot be made over the defendant's objection, Brookhart V. Janis, 384 U.S. 1 (1966), and do not deal with situations where the defendant, prior to trial, objected to representation by the attorney who was making the decisions on his behalf. Fay V. Noia, 372 U.S. 391 (1963); Henry V. Mississippi, 379 U.S. 442 (1965).

After stating that "the right to defend is given directly to the accused," the court adds that "The counsel provision supplements this design." (422 U.S. 806, 819 -20.) This must mean that when a dispute arises between the accused and his counsel it is counsel's duty to follow the desires of his client.

The language and spirit of the Sixth Amendment contemplate that counsel, like the other defense tools guaranteed by the Amendment shall be an aid to a willing defendant.....

* * * * * * *

An unwanted counsel "represents" the defendant only through a tenuous and unacceptable legal fiction. Unless the accused has acquiesced in such representation, the defense presented is not the defense guaranteed him by the Constitution, for in a very real sense, it is not his defense. Faretta, 422 U,S, 806, 820.

As the court notes, the Sixth Amendment is not satisfied where a defense, however expert, is made for the accused; the Amendment is satisfied only when the accused's right to make his personal defense is honored.

The Sixth Amendment dose not provide merely that a defense shall be made for the accused; it grants to the accused personally the right to make his defense. Faretta, (422 U.S. 806, 319).

The use of counsel to assist an accused in making a "personal" defense would be a meaningless right if, by slecting to proceed by counsel, an accused surrendered all control over "his" defense, for then the defense, "is stripped of the personal charater upon which the Amendment insists." (422 U.S. 806, 820).

In People V. Windam, 129 Cal. Eptr. 828, 58 Cal. App. 3d 347 (1976), the court was of the opinion that even after initially consenting to representation by counsel, the accused, during the trial, could successfully assert his right to self-representation:

One could indeed infer from this passage that the defendant's consent "at the outset" justified forcing unwanted counsel upon him later in the trial.

However, that is not exactly what the court says, and there is an equally strong implication of the opposite in another portion of the opinion:

"In other setting as well, the court has indicated that a defendant has a constitutionally protected right to represent himself in a criminal trial.

For example, in Snyder V. Massachsetts, 291 U.S. 97, the Court held that the Confrontation Clause of the Sirth Amendment gives the accused a right to be present at all stages of the proceedings where fundamental fairness might be thwarted by his absence. This right to 'presence' was based upon the promise that the 'defense may be made easier if the accused is premitted to be present at the examination of jurors or the summing up of counsel for it will be in his power, if present, to give advise or suggestion or even to supercede his lawyers altogether and conduct the trial himself.'

(Id., at 106.)" (Faretta) at 815-16). People V. Windham, 129 Cal. Rptr. 828, 831.

PARDON BOARD

SPRING SESSION MEETS ON THE FIRST MONDAY IN APRIL AND FIRST MONDAY IN MAY.

APPLICATIONS: All inmates who are planning for appearence at the next sessions are encouraged to submit their requests to SUPERVISOR OF RECORDS, at CCI SOMERS.

Their request should be submitted immediately, if possible, and inmates are reminded that the last day for recieving requests is February 25, 1977.

APPLICATIONS RESULTING IN A STARRED (*) CASE: Under the established rules of the Pardon Boa d, cases cannot be heard if the petioner has:
(1) Appeared within the year. (2) Served less than one year. This one year cannot include jail-time. (3) Appeared or was eligible for parole.

The Department of Corrections nor the Pardon Board will assign Attorneys. Each inmate must retain his own council.

A starred case in one of these categories is very rarely heard. By therefore waiting for a regular session, not only are inmates saved the labor of preparing required letters, but friends, lawyers, prison staff, Statess Attorney and the board is spared the effort which should be given the regular petitioners.

It is suggested that before undertaking the task of a starred petition, an inmate should seek the advice of the prison staff which is readily given.

No man more blest beneath heaven is living.


Continuacion de la semana pasada
